Things to know before you go!

Trail Ride – approximately 4 hours

Pilares Canyon is located 3/4 of a mile east of mile marker 10 off Hwy 173 (Navajo Dam Road from Aztec)

Signs will be posted before the turn - go slow as it is a left turn just over a hill coming from Aztec!

Truck and Trailer Parking - This is a **self-guided** ride. There is plenty of room to park along the road in the canyon.

Trails - The trail is not marked. There will be flags on trees within 150 ft. of an arch.

Guide Book - Guide books will be issued when you check in. GPS coordinates for the arches as well as a map are listed in the guidebook.

CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT - Check In and Check Out will be held at Tiger Park -1301 Old Spanish Trail, Aztec. The park is located just off Hwy 173, 2 miles from the turn off Hwy 550. **Follow the Signs.**

Your ticket for the BBQ, if purchased, will be given when you check out.

RULES OF THE RIDE

Due to the number of riders, multiple riding levels, liability concerns and to ensure the fun and safety of everyone, the following rules must be followed.

By signing the release form you agree to follow these rules:

- Safety and courtesy to other riders is a priority
- No Stallions
- Riding helmets are recommended for adults, mandatory for minors
- No jumping or galloping your horse is allowed
- No reckless, careless or discourteous behavior is allowed
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted
- Stay away from all pipelines and equipment - this includes well pads

Check in starts at 8:00. Ride out at your convenience.

4 x 4 Tour – approximately 2 hours

Wear appropriate clothing – long pants, sturdy shoes and hat recommended

This tour will take approximately 2 hours – bring water

BBQ at Tiger Park - starts at 1:00 p.m.

If you signed up to ride or tour and attend the BBQ, your ticket includes the BBQ

Additionally, there will be items to raffle displayed around the Pavilion.

Tickets for the raffle items can be purchased prior to or day of the ride.

All Riders Must be checked out by NOON or the search begins!
